Grade 10

- ⇒ The 2024-2025 School Year begins on Tuesday, September 3, 2024 at **8:10 AM**.
- ⇒ The first day will be a full day with dismissal at 2:40 PM.
- ⇒ Busses will run as per Southland schedule – check the Southland website for further details at www.southland.ca
- ⇒ Registration Procedures will be posted at the entrance of the school.

Second Day - Wednesday, September 4, 2024: There are no grade 10 classes this day
Grade 11

- ⇒ The 2024-2025 School Year for grade 11 begins on Wednesday, September 4, 2024 from **8:10 AM-11:15 AM**.
- ⇒ Busses will run at the regular morning pick-up times and will be available to transport students home at 11:15 am

Grade 12

- ⇒ The 2024-2025 School Year for grade 12 begins on Wednesday, September 4, 2024 from **12:15 PM-2:40 PM**.
- ⇒ Busses will run 3 hours later than the normal morning pick up time.
- ⇒ Registration Procedures will be posted at the entrance of the school.

Fees:

2024-2025 school fee invoices will be available online at <https://mhcbe.schoolcashionline.com> by the end of September and payments can be made on SchoolCash or at the McCoy office by **October 15, 2024**. The preferred payment method is online but you can also pay at the school using cash, cheque, debit, Visa, or Mastercard.

Students who have outstanding fees (from previous years) or lost textbooks must reconcile on SchoolCash or at the office at the beginning of the school year.

How does it work??? It's easy as 1, 2, 3!

1. Get a job (you may already have one). Download from the McCoy webpage (programs tab) a work experience contract and complete all sections. Email the WE supervisor as soon as your contract is completed! → rylee.shulson@mhcbe.ab.ca
2. Keep track of the hours you've worked on a timesheet and submit it to the google classroom or drop it off in the mail slot at the front of the school. Timesheets are available on the McCoy website.
3. Every 25 hours = 1 credit. Students will be contacted when it's time to fill out evaluation forms.

Benefits of Work Experience

1. Students going into gr. 11 and 12 can earn up to 15 credits which count towards your High School Diploma
2. Work experience credits can be combined with in-class grades for scholarship opportunities
3. Provides real-life experience and timetabling flexibility
4. You must contact a supervisor and have a contract before hours worked can be used to earn credits!
5. **HCS 3000 is a prerequisite for work experience and is typically completed in grade 10**
